Modes of tumour spread - TB lesions in lung **Cardiovascular system**: Atherosclerosis - myocardial infarction **Respiratory system**: pulmonary embolism - bronchogenic carcinoma **GIT**: Gastric carcinoma - Dysentery **Hepatobiliary**: Hepatitis - Gall bladder stones **Kidneys and urinary tract**: Pyelonephritis - Obstructive uropathy **Male genital system**: Seminoma- prostatic enlargement **Female genital system & breast**: dysfunctional uterine bleeding-Ovarian tumours - breast carcinoma **Endocrine**: goiter- Thyroid carcinoma - diabetes mellitus **Hematopoeitic and lymphopoeitic systems**: Hodgkin lymphoma -Egyptian splenomegaly **Skeletal system and joints**: Osteomyelitis - Sarcomas of the bone **Nervous system**: Gliomas - meningioma
